GSLIS ARCHIVES MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

The Thirty-six Credit Hour (12 courses) Archives Management Program includes:

- **15 credits = GSLIS Core Courses** : LIS 407, LIS 415, LIS 488, LIS 403, LIS 404 (Note : LIS 442 may be substituted as an Archives alternative to 404 with the prerequisite 438).
- **18 credits = Four Core Archives Courses (12 credits) plus one elective from each Core Archives Areas (6 credits).**
- **3 credits = One Free Elective** (may be additional Archives courses, recommended electives or **ANY** others from the GSLIS curriculum)
