

Interlibrary Loan Access

Distance learners are encouraged if possible to use their local libraries in order to expedite delivery of material, e.g. reducing the delivery time of non-Simmons books and eliminating the need to mail material back to Simmons. If this is not possible, then the Simmons Library is happy to provide that service which is accessible either through the Library homepage at <http://my.simmons.edu/library/> and then Services or directly at <http://libfs1.simmons.edu/illiad/>. If the book is a LIS Z title not owned by either your library or local consortia libraries, then you should request it directly from us as we may be one of only a few holders.

Books including Dissertations:

Books requested by the distance learners, including those owned by Simmons Library as well as those borrowed from other libraries, are mailed directly to the address you indicate on your ILL form. When filling out the interlibrary loan request form, be sure to indicate you are an MLIP student in the note field

Delivery usually takes 5-10 business days for books owned by Simmons and longer for material borrowed from other libraries. That time will depend how quickly it is received from the lender plus an additional 7-10 business days for us to send it to you.

Journal Articles

Journal articles requested by the distance learner are delivered in the quickest manner: via Iliad/ODYSSEY (electronic delivery) via e-mail notification to your Simmons ILL Account.

Delivery usually takes 2-5 business days.

Note: Before requesting either books or journal articles, be sure to check our online catalog for the availability of e-books, fulltext articles or dissertations.
